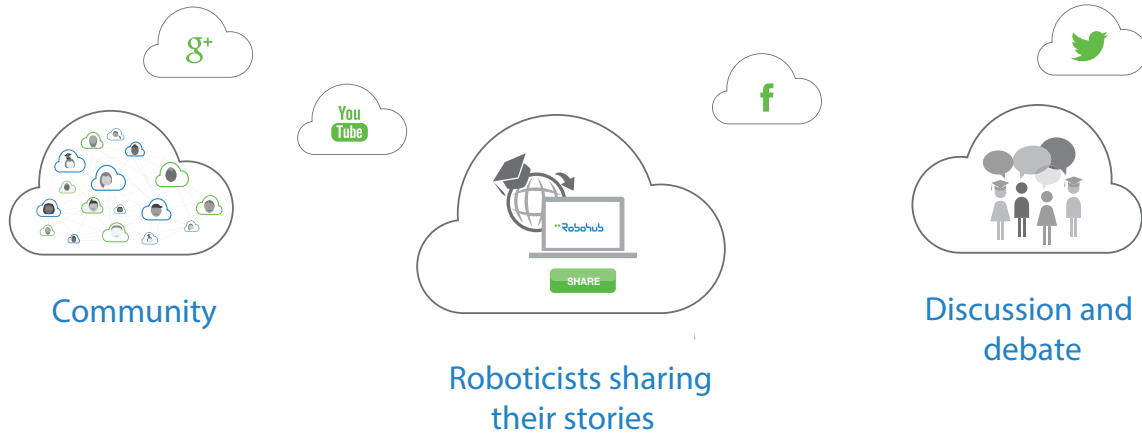

We're more than an online news site

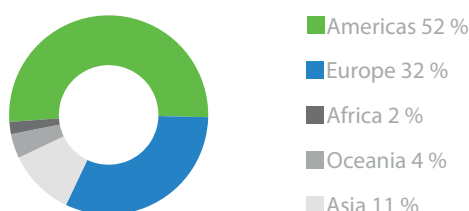

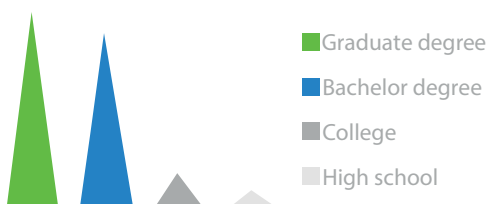
